Good Morning to all!

There is certainly good news this month.

The year to date ending April 30, visitor to the website figures total: 31,253 visitors, and we hosted 39,637 visitor sessions!

In April our new AMEPilot SCAUWG.ORG exclusive original commentary premiere edition was visited 133 times, (and same included some high-level representatives of SoCal and LAX tower) The Practice Area section 111 times and the chart changes proposed page was seen by 102 visitors. Our EVENTS page was visited 453 times. Other primary pages were successful as well!

The Hot News Scroll Line has featured the latest FAA statements regarding 737 MAX UPDATEs, The Biodiesel movement, the AMT shortage, Performance Based Aircraft Certifications, the FAA and UAS, and the latest FAA 20-year aviation forecast.

Updated Events pages are Standard Operating Procedure – and we include a 150-200-mile radius in our coverage. This month we added may AIAA Events

New Safety Videos for Deer Valley were included into the So Cal airports section.

I also added NTSB ALERT INFO re: Stabilized Approaches to the Info Warehouse, and I just added a How to Survive a Ditching presentation that originated at Oshkosh, that awards WINGS credit as well – plus Added an "ADS-B LIGHT" article to the IW – It Addresses amateur-built, light-sport, planes with an experimental type certificate, and the criteria necessary for using a non-certified ADS-B installation.

Top of the Page Slides feature the PHPA Lifetime Achievement Award to be given to, and honoring SCAUWG co-founder Pat Carey. We Congratulate AOPA on their 80th Anniversary year. Thanks Tom Lasser, we have publicized to Aviators that the CA Army National Guard is looking for you. Self-Assessment standards recommended by NBAA are linked to. And want to know more about the new Electric aircraft on view at the Aero Germany show? Paul Bertorelli of AVweb made a great video we link to. And of course we supported the Airport Safety/Runway Safety Mtg at Chino, as Joe Santoro and Dr. Paul Foster are working hard to improve both of those concerns.
