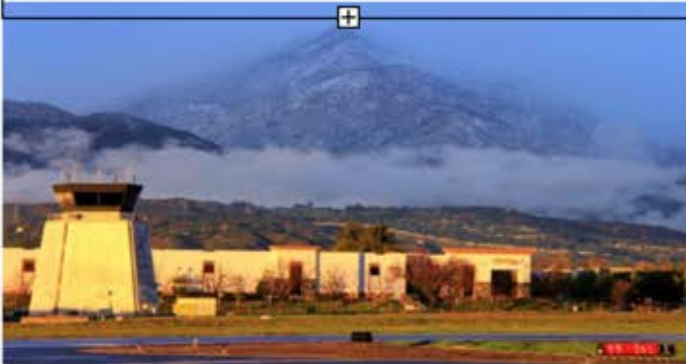

## Airport Traffic Control Tower Adjusted Hours of Operation New Hours:

Starting 05/04/2020 - 08:00 to 16:00 local

To ensure the continued resiliency of the air traffic control system amid the COVID-19 pandemic, the FAA is adjusting the hours of operation at Brackett Airfield Airport Traffic Control Tower. Making these adjustments allows for continued safe operations throughout the national airspace system while minimizing health risks to our workforce.



## Runway Safety During Tower Closure

Please be extra observant when operating near or crossing a runway when the tower is closed. Remember, there may be a non-radio aircraft inbound or departing the runway, please do not assume that a no reply to a "crossing the active runway" means no traffic. **BE VIGILANT!**

## In-Flight or Airport Emergencies

*Airport Operations*

When the tower is closed, pilots and airport customers are required to use the Brackett Airport Common Traffic Advisory Frequency (CTAF), 118.2. Airport Operations will be monitoring the frequency. Should you experience an in-flight or airport emergency, contact Airport Operations via CTAF to activate Airport Rescue and Firefighting (ARFF). If you are unable to reach Airport Operations please dial 911. Airport local City of La Verne Firefighting services are approximately three minutes away.
