

INFORMAL AIRSPACE MEETING

SUBJECT: Planned Establishment of Class C airspace at Long Beach (LGB), CA.

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) will hold two informal airspace meetings regarding a plan to establish the Long Beach Class C airspace area. The purpose of the meetings is to solicit aeronautical comments on the proposal's effect on the planned action (FAA Order 7400.2)

The changes are expected to make the Class C airspace area fully support the procedures for the current operations. The chart depicting the planned Long Beach Class C airspace area design is included to assist in the preparation of comments prior to the meeting.

MEETING PROCEDURES:

- a. The meetings will be open to all persons on a space-available basis. There will be no admission fee or other charge to attend and participate.
- b. The meetings will be informal in nature and conducted by one or more representatives of the FAA. Each participant will be given an opportunity to deliver comments or make a presentation, although a time limit may be imposed. Only comments concerning the plan to establish the Class C airspace area at Long Beach, CA. will be accepted.
- c. Each person wishing to make a presentation will be asked to sign in so those time frames can be established. These meetings will not be adjourned until everyone on the list has had an opportunity address the panel. These meetings may be adjourned at any time if all persons present have had an opportunity to speak.
- d. Position papers or other handout material relating to the substance of these meetings will be accepted. Participants wishing to submit handout material should present an original and two copies (3 copies total) to the presiding officer. There should be additional copies of each handout available for other attendees.
- e. These meetings will not be formally recorded. However, a summary of comments made at the meeting will be filed in the docket.
