Happy to report that we have maintained the high monthly visitor count in February. For the 28 day month SCAUWG.ORG saw a unique daily visitor count total 4201, or an average of about 150 per day. The page impression rate was 3.84, and our total monthly log-ons by real people numbered 4806 for the month.
