I am happy to report that we have maintained a high monthly visitor count in April. SCAUWG.ORG saw a unique daily visitor count total of 4726, Up a bit from March. The page impression rate was 3.23 – the same as March, and our session count, the total monthly log-ons by real people, numbered 5131 for the month, also up a bit from March. Our Info Warehouse Page 3 was visited 705 times during the month.

During the month there were by comparison quite a few GPS Testing Notices that we published on our GPS Testing Page. Even now (5/11) Yuma Proving Grounds remains an active alert.
