María Elena Durazo to Succeed Hilda Solis as LA County Supervisor

State Senator **María Elena Durazo** has won the election to succeed Hilda Solis as Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors member for District 1, which covers areas from Silver Lake through Boyle Heights and the San Gabriel Valley to Pomona thelalocal.org.

Durazo, a Democrat and former labor leader, defeated Elaine Alaniz in the June 3, 2026 primary, securing about **56% of the vote** compared to Alaniz's roughly 16% thelalocal.org.

The other candidates trailed behind. If official results confirm her victory, Durazo will take office representing nearly 2 million residents, including unincorporated East Los Angeles and parts of the San Gabriel Valley thelalocal.org.

Durazo, first elected to the California State Senate in 2018 and reelected in 2022, has a strong record in labor advocacy, having served as executive vice president of Unite Here and as the first woman elected secretary-treasurer of the Los Angeles County Federation of Labor thelalocal.org. She has championed policies to protect immigrant communities, expand healthcare access, and address homelessness.

As supervisor, Durazo has pledged to continue her focus on fair wages, healthcare, and compassionate government, while opposing tax breaks for those who don't need them thelalocal.org. She will join the five county supervisors who manage an annual budget of nearly \$50 billion and set countywide policy on issues like jails, juvenile halls, foster care, and the LA County Sheriff's Department
